Spring CLASS Observations were scheduled with the teachers. The observations were conducted during all parts of the day. Most classrooms had experienced Head Start Lead Teachers being observed. Linden 172, Texarkana 124, Pittsburg 164 and Atlanta 153 had Teacher Assistants acting as the Lead Teacher. Linden 172 and Atlanta 153 had long term substitutes acting as the Teacher Assistant. Texarkana 124 had two Head Start Teacher Assistants in the classroom.

The program improved scores in all domains from the Fall 2016 to the Spring 2017 observations. Emotional Support had a gain of 0.31. Classroom Organization had a gain of 0.40. Instructional Support had a gain of 0.45. Teachstone research states that small

incremental gains in CLASS scores can result in greater gains in children performance.


